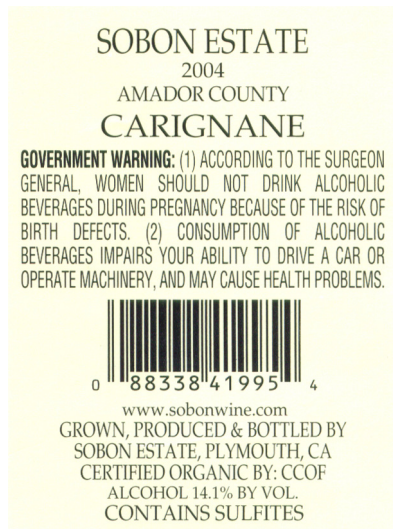

# 2004 ReZerve Carignane

## Winemaker Notes

---



### DESCRIPTION

A little-known grape with origins in Spain. It is one of the most widely planted grapes in the South of France. When planted in our low-fertility soils it yields less than two tons per acre. Our growing conditions produce small bunches of tiny grapes with high tannin, excellent flavors, and dark colors. The wine should be at its peak drinkability from 2007-2010. Serve it with rich dishes of short ribs or lamb, or with cheeses at the end of your meal.

### FOOD PAIRING

Goes well with grilled meats – try it with your BBQ this summer.
