2011 Zinfandel

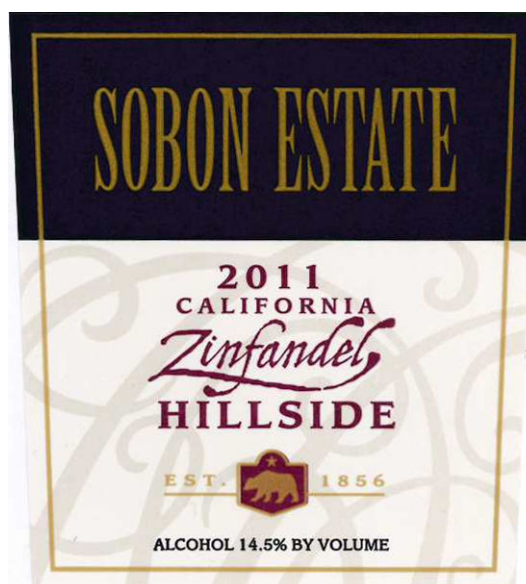
