### 2011 Sangiovese

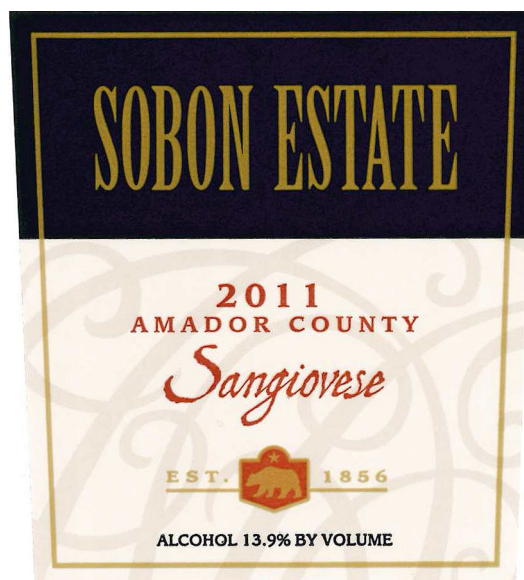
