2013 Zinfandel

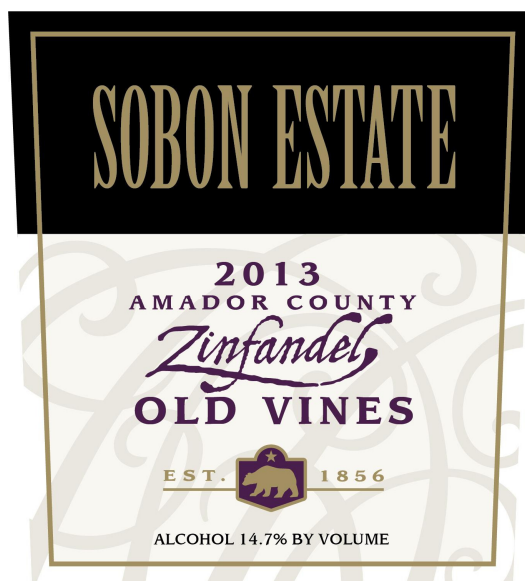
