From our well-drained hillside estate vineyard comes this naturally made, sustainably grown premium white wine. Pale straw in appearance, but rich and inviting, with aromas suggesting peach blossom and jasmine. Subtle hints of minerality on the palate give way to flavors reminiscent of apricots and kiwi fruit; with a long lingering medium dry finish.
