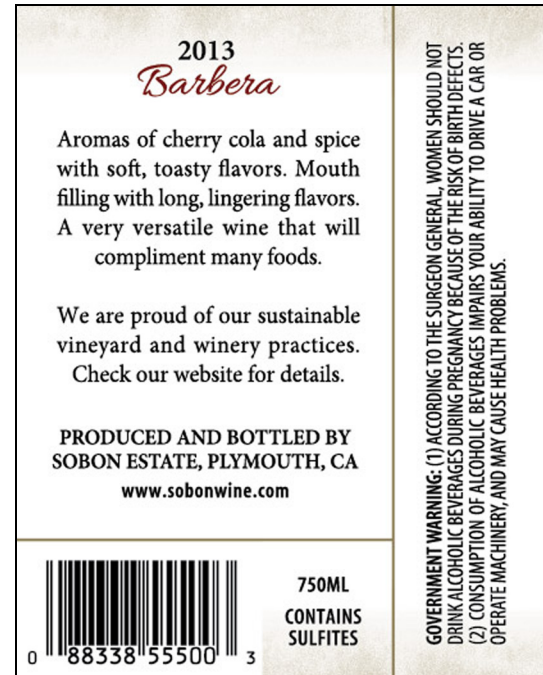
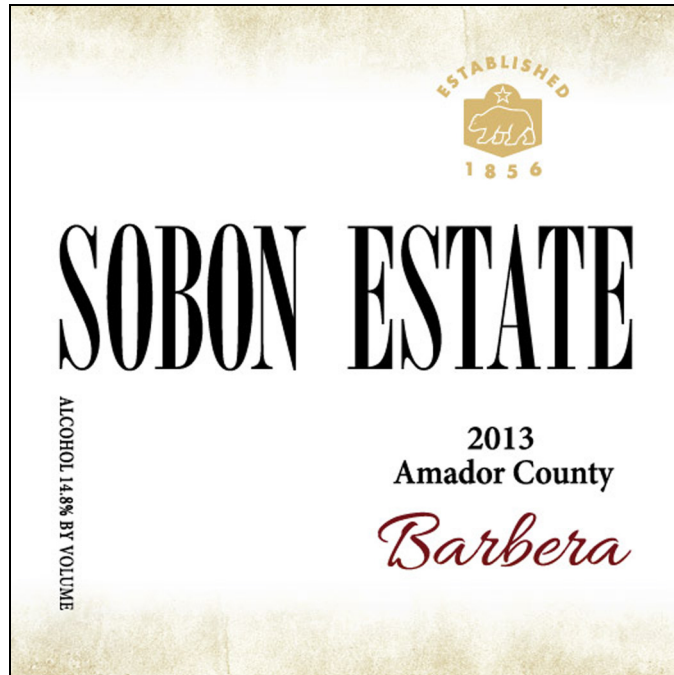


2013 Barbera Winemaker Notes



DESCRIPTION Old world tradition meets new world style in this rich, heavily fruited take on Foothill Barbera. With its precise varietal character of ripe plum and cherries; Great depth and vanilla accents highlight this wine, grown in rocky volcanic soils high above the Shenandoah Valley. A long lingering finish defines the balance and integration that brings all components into focus and harmony, allowing the wine to be paired with a multitude of dishes, including grilled meats, soft ripe cheeses and mild to savory sausages.
