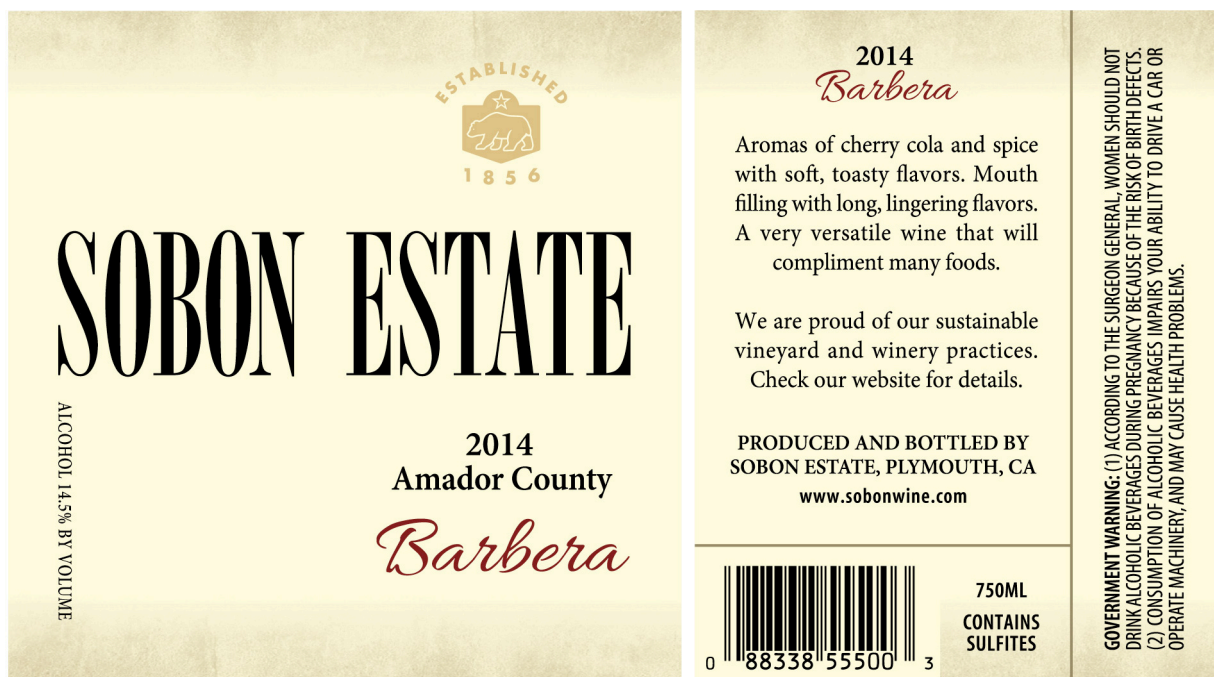

DESCRIPTION Old world tradition meets new world style in this rich, heavily fruited take on Foothill Barbera. With its precise varietal character of ripe plum and cherries; Great depth and vanilla accents highlight this wine, grown in rocky volcanic soils high above the Shenandoah Valley. A long lingering finish defines the balance and integration that brings all components into focus and harmony, allowing the wine to be paired with a multitude of dishes.

FOOD PAIRING Its bright acidity makes it a perfect match for many dishes, including grilled meats, soft ripe cheeses and mild to savory sausages.
