DESCRIPTION

From our own sustainably farmed vines planted in 1980. These fully mature vines produced a smaller than normal crop of excellent fruit this vintage, resulting in a wine with much richness and depth. Extended aging in new French Oak gives this wine characteristics of sweet vanilla and toasted hazelnut that balance out the heavier notes of cassis, jam, and dark plum.
