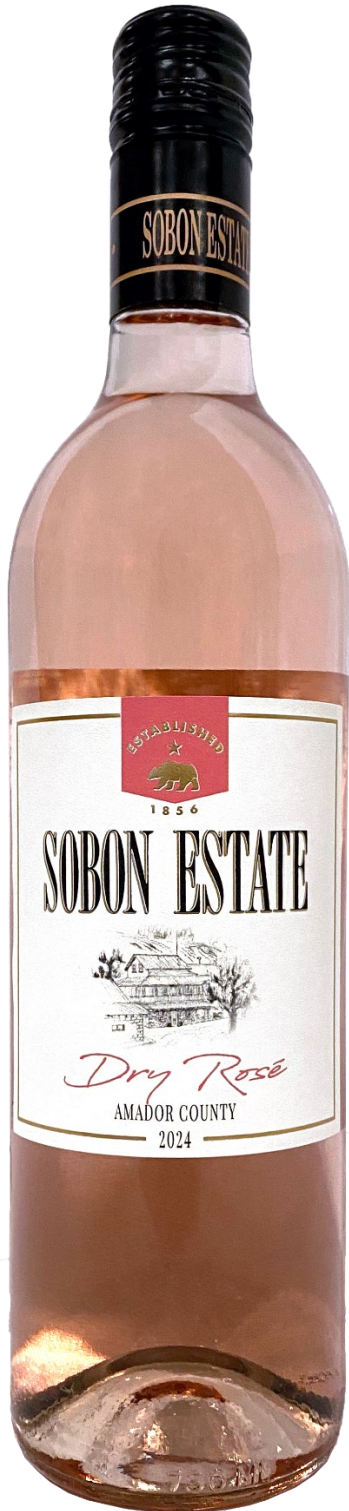

VINEYARD HISTORY

Our estate Grenache vineyards planted in the late 80's are sustainably grown and thrive in the hot climate of our California Shenandoah Valley AVA. Traditionally used for our popular Dry Rosé, our Grenache grapes are also made into the occasional red wine depending on the harvest.

WINEMAKERS NOTES

Bright, fresh & zesty, this estate bottled Rose is made primarily from sustainably grown Grenache; Salmon colored in appearance with a delicate hint of fresh strawberries, cinnamon & watermelon. Crisp, dry, and exuberantly fruity with a clean finish.

PAIRINGS

Pairs exceptionally well with prosciutto wrapped melon, smoked wild salmon, and spicy tuna rolls.
